

Special Meeting
Of the
Assumption Parish Police Jury

Monday, February 27, 2023
5:00 O'clock p.m.

1. The Special Meeting of the Assumption Parish Police Jury was called to order by Police Jury President Leroy Blanchard in the Assumption Parish Police Jury Chamber located at 4813 Highway 1, Napoleonville, Louisiana.
2. Police Jurors recorded as present were: Mr. Ron Alcorn, Ward 1; Mr. Jeff Naquin, Ward 2; Mr. Michael Dias, Ward 5; Mr. Chris Carter, Ward 6; Mr. Leroy Blanchard, Ward 7; Mr. Jamie Ponville, Ward 8.
Police Jurors recorded as absent were: Mr. Irving Comeaux, Ward 3; Mr. Patrick Johnson, Ward 4; Mr. Myron Matherne, Ward 9.
3. President Leroy Blanchard led the prayer and Police Juror Michael Dias led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
4. President Leroy Blanchard opened the meeting to the public to receive comments, questions or concerns regarding matters on the agenda. Following three (3) calls, there were no comments received.
5. Police Juror Ron Alcorn offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Michael Dias, "THAT, the Police Jury enter into executive session to discuss and ratify new hire rates for the Permit Officer and Accountants." The motion was unanimously adopted.
6. Police Juror Ron Alcorn offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Michael Dias, "THAT, the Police Jury approve to resume regular session." The motion was unanimously adopted.
7. President Leroy Blanchard stated that the Jury entered executive session to discuss the ratification of new hire rates of pay if additional advertising were required. He stated that the Jury agreed on a salary range of \$33,000 - \$38,000 for the Permit Officer and \$43,000-\$53,000 for the Accountant positions. He then stated that for the additional accountants the salary range would be \$40,000 - \$46,000.
8. Police Juror Ron Alcorn offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Jeff Naquin, "THAT, the Police Jury approve the rate of pay for the Permit Officer \$33,000-\$38,000, Accountant \$43,000 - \$53,000 and additional accountants \$40,000 - \$46,000 if additional advertising were required." The motion was unanimously adopted.
9. Police Juror Jamie Ponville offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Michael Dias, "THAT, the Police Jury approve and authorize the President to sign the affidavit stating parish purchases/maintains pumps for voluntary drainage districts in an effort to have a "Rate Minimum" charge with Entergy for said voluntary districts, 134 Oak St." The motion was unanimously adopted. 10. Police Juror Jeff Naquin offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Jamie Ponville, "THAT, there being no further business to come before the Assumption Parish Police Jury, the meeting be adjourned." The motion was unanimously adopted.
